Because of the occurrences in France, the Russian government became fearful that similar disturbances might erupt in its territory, and hence the order was given to institute the examination. The same situation obtains on the Jewish front. When we see such a disavowal of Judaism and assimilation in Germany, we must immediately examine our defences and repair all breaches."
