The third son, E. Samuel Adler, was a merchant. He was also gifted with a brilliant mind, but did not devote himself exclusively to Torah learning and endeavor: R. Israel's one daughter was the wife of R. Elijah Eliezer Grodzensky, and their daughter in turn was married to the famous R. Chaim Ozer Grodzensky of Vilna. His second daughter, Hoda Liebe was first married to R. Aaron Sidersky of Grodno, and after her divorce, to David Morein of Krinki.

R. Israel's descendants multiplied. Many of them became great Torah scholars, Musar exponents and famous personalities, who spread to all corners of the world and occupy prominent positions in Jewry to this day.
